Timothy HugginsCollege of Missionary Aviation



The Missionary College of Aviation is a new ministry located in Keystone Heights, Florida. Tim started out training groups of high school students with a passion for missionary aviation work. The camp gave the high schoolers a taste of real-time flight experience, technical instruction and spiritual guidance in an no-frills environment like they would experience on the mission field.

He soon realized that most of the teens who felt the calling of God to the mission field to take on a pilot's role were faced with real, practical dilemmas. Most flight programs are too expensive for interested students to afford, forcing them into insurmountable debt or a different career path. Huggins saw the need for an affordable higher-education institution to train service-ready, missionary-minded pilots. And so the College of Missionary Aviation was born.

Qualified pilots from the college may begin to fly missionary flights to the Bahamas, Haiti and the Dominican Republic as well as other islands. They will gain flight experience and work as apprentices fulfilling their requirements for th A& P licenses needed by many missionary organizations.

Their Mission Statement: To provide high school graduates or equivalent with streamlined, professional and economical education and training that meets the requirements of the FAA and mission organizations in a Christian environment with a balanced focus on safety, professional standards and mission orientation.
