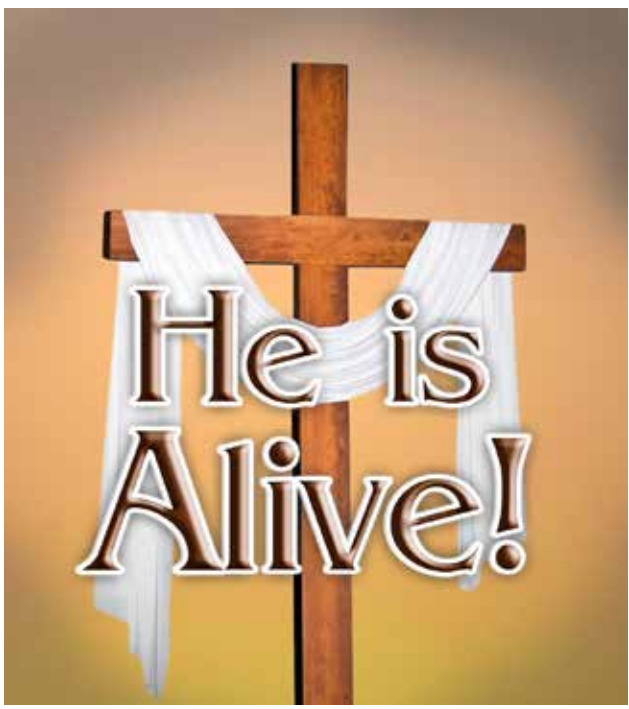

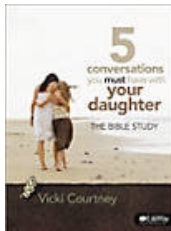

Your daughter is growing up. The world has a lot to say to her, and she's starting to listen. Even if she doesn't know it, she needs you more than ever. It's time to press in, tell her some things she might not know (or might have forgotten) about who she is in God's eyes. Just five conversations, but they could be the basis for a whole new way of relating to your daughter.

Provide a Meal for Shisa House

Shisa House is the halfway house for women prisoners where our ladies in the Women's Prison Ministry go once a month to do Bible studies, provide a meal and be an encouragement to the women trying to re-establish their lives outside of prison.

Callahan Barbecue provides a meal for \$75 to feed 15-20 women. If you would like to help fund a meal, you or your Bible Fellowship Group can collect the money, put it in an offering envelope marked "Women's Prison Ministry" and put it in the offering plate or turn it in to the church office.
