MISSIONARIES NEW TO GLOBAL IMPACT CELEBRATION

Chris Kellermeyer and Nathan Shaver serve together in the Indianapolis, Indiana area and will be traveling together to share their ministries with us during Global Impact Celebration.



Church Planter **Chris Kellermeyer** was an atheist until he picked up a tract in his wife's family home during a Easter visit. Now he is the *Send City Missionary /Ministry Coordinator*

for the North American Mission Board in Indianapolis, Indiana. He has been a church planter for twelve years and has served in Indianapolis for three.

Nathan Shaver and his wife Rachelle are church planters in Speedway, Indiana.

The Town of Speedway, incorporated in 1926, is a separate governmental unit within the city of Indianapolis. The entire Indianapolis Speedway is located within the Town of Speedway.



Nathan became a Christian at age nine. He has pastored Christ Community Church in Speedway for one year. Previously he lead worship for college campus ministries, youth camps and local churches. He also had a pastoral ministry in a rural community on the west side of Indianapolis for five years.

He and his wife were moving toward becoming missionaries in the Middle East and then realized that there was a great need for ministry among the Middle Eastern immigrants living closest to them in their city. Many have difficult stories of fleeing their country and finding western culture difficult to navigate and acclimate into.

Nathan and his wife have five children: Benjamin, 14, Judah, 12, Caitlyn, 7, Levi, 4 and Luke who just turned 1.

PASTOR'S BIBLE STUDY

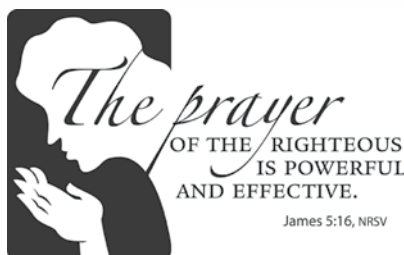
Led by Pastor Lynn Hyatt weekly in the Chapel
