Introducing a New Mission:

Each year during the Global Impact Celebration leadership introduces new missions so that the church might continue to find new ways to serve the community and bring others to Christ. One of the new ministries that have been invited by the Jerusalem team this year is:



Rethreaded was founded by Kristin Keen. She lived and worked in Kolkata, India for five years where she helped co-found a business that could offer women in the sex trade there a safe haven. Upon her return to Jacksonville she felt called to fight the sex trade on a local level.

“Rethreaded is a social entrepreneurship that is breaking the cycle of the sex trade by offering viable and creative work to those affected by the sex trade (i.e. human trafficking, prostitution, drug addiction, pornography and strip clubs).”

Our vision is to unravel the effects of the sex trade by fighting business with business on a global and local level. The multibillion dollar sex industry is founded on the exploitation of mostly women and children. As a business we want to provide safe, viable, and dignity-giving work to survivors of the sex trade allowing them to be who they were created to be.”



BIBLE STUDY




PASTOR'S BIBLE STUDY
