




A Beautiful Design

Online Giving



To use your bank's "bill-pay" feature for your regular giving, set it up as you would anything else that you are paying on-line. Use your envelope number as your account number.

Many bill-pay sites do not let you itemize your giving (such as \$100 for Tithe, \$50 for Faith Commitment for a total of \$150). If this is the case, you would set up a separate bill-pay for each giving designation: one with your envelope number followed by the word TITHE, another with the same envelope number followed by the word FAITH, another with the word Building Fund, etc.

You can set up your bill-pay to be paid in whatever period you wish: weekly, biweekly, monthly, etc. You can also change amounts at anytime by editing your bank account on-line.




"Kids Worship for Life" provides opportunities for all children to connect with God through musical expression, art activities, Bible study and group interaction.
