CENTRIFUGE

Our **Middle School Students** will be divided into groups for recreation and Bible study. Each activity serves a specific purpose and is explained so students can make application in their lives.

Students will also participate in Track Times. Track Times are created to give students the opportunity to participate in something with which they are familiar or try something new! Each track is led by a member of the FUGE staff.
