- The Greek word, “baptize” means, “to be completely ENVELOPED.”

We are COMMANDED to baptize and be baptized.

Matthew 28:19-20

- There is no SAVING GRACE in the act of baptism.
- Baptism is an act of OBEDIENCE and a TESTIMONY of Jesus’ lordship over us.

We follow Jesus’ EXAMPLE when we are baptized.

Matthew 3:13-17

- His baptism is a model of HUMILITY and OBEDIENCE for us.

Baptism is a “PICTURE” of our salvation. *Romans 6:4*

- It illustrates Jesus’ death, burial, and resurrection FOR US.
- It illustrates our “death” to an old life and our “resurrection” to a new life IN HIM.

Baptism is a PUBLIC DECLARATION of our faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior. *Acts 8:36-37*

- It is an unashamed submission to His LORDSHIP.
- It is one of our first steps of obedience AFTER salvation.
